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About this document

This "WinActor Installation Manual" (hereinafter referred to as "this manual") describes the steps before using WinActor.

- ① Purchasing a license from an agency
- ② Obtaining a WinActor installer from the agency
- ③ Installing WinActor
- ④ Launching WinActor

If you use the evaluation edition of WinActor, the following steps are not necessary.

There are three ways to register the license: "Online license registration," "License registration via WinActor license issuance site," and "License registration via agency." Use one of these three ways to register the license.

- 1. Online license registration
 - ⑤ Registering the license online on WinActor
- 2. License registration via WinActor license issuance site
 - ⑤ Applying a license issuance on the WinActor license issuance site
 - ⑥ Downloading the issued license on the WinActor license issuance site
 - ⑦ Registering the license
- 3. License registration via agency
 - ⑤ Sending a product ID file to the agency
 - ⑥ Obtaining a license file from the agency
 - ⑦ Registering the license




Window images and texts used in this manual may vary depending on the OS and settings.

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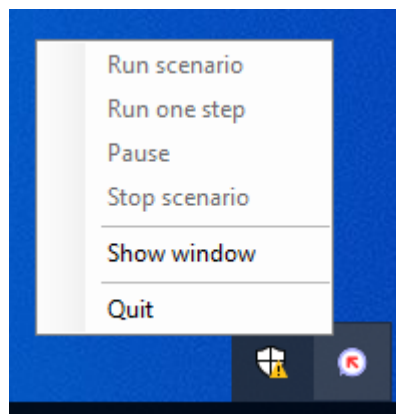
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1. Installing WinActor

This chapter describes how to install WinActor.



- If you are already using WinActor Ver.5 or Ver.6, specify a **different folder from WinActor Ver.5 or Ver.6** as a folder to install WinActor Ver.7.
The default folder name is "WinActor" for WinActor Ver.5 or Ver.6, and "WinActor7" for WinActor Ver.7.
- If you are already using WinActor Ver.7 and want to update it to a newer version of WinActor Ver.7, the update procedure is the same as the installation procedure.
Follow the installation instructions in this chapter to update.
- Carry out the installation with WinActor closed.
When WinActor is launched, its icon will be stored in the task tray at the lower right of the Windows screen. You can close WinActor by right-clicking the icon and selecting 'Quit.'



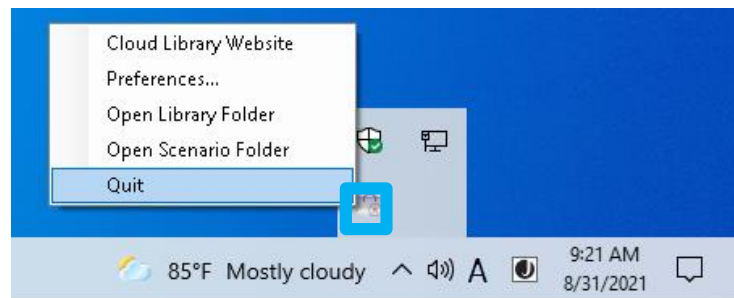
- If the extension function of WinActor is installed in a browser, stop running the browser while updating WinActor.
 - There are two types of installers, one is for administrator and the other one is for standard user. Select the installer according to the role of the user to use WinActor.
 - If multiple users use WinActor on one Windows 10 or Windows 11 computer, install WinActor using the installer for administrator.

- WABAgent is not necessary for WinActor Ver.7.3.0 and its successors.
Before installing or updating WinActor, quit WABAgent and delete the startup shortcut of it following the procedure described below.

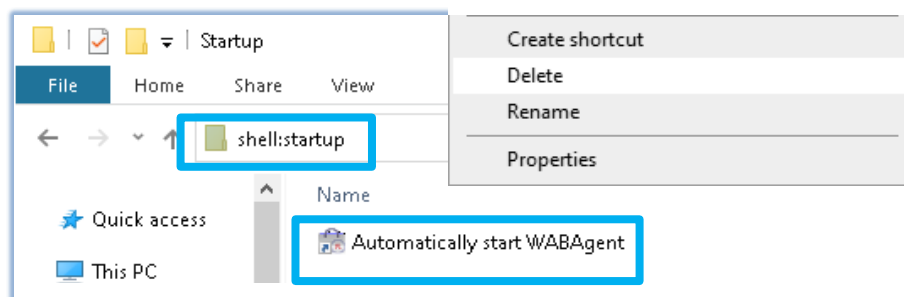
Open the task tray, which is called overflow area, at the right bottom of the Windows screen clicking the 'Show hidden icons' arrow on the task bar.

When the icon of WABAgent exists, right click the icon and select 'Quit.' When the icon does not exist, just proceed to the next step.



Then, enter "shell:startup" into the address bar of the Windows explorer to display the startup folder.

When the shortcut "Automatically start WABAgent" exists in the startup folder, delete the shortcut. When the shortcut does not exist, skip this step.



1.1 Installer for administrator

This section describes the installation method for administrator.

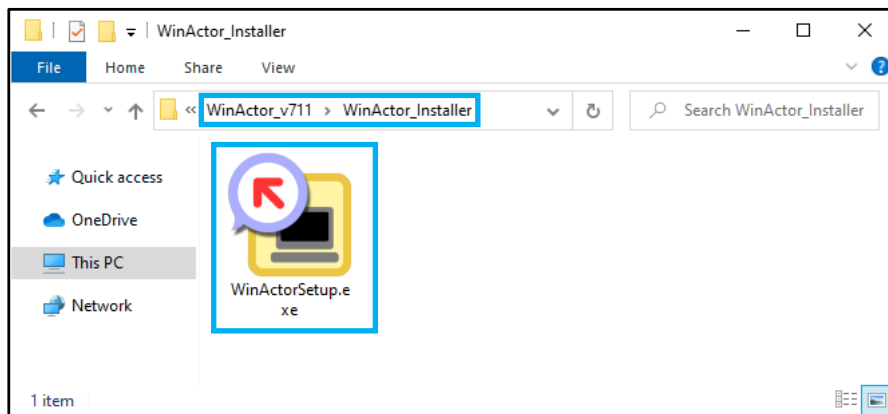
If you already have WinActor Ver.7 installed, you can update it with the same procedure.

1.1.1 Installation method for administrator

Install WinActor using the installer for administrator.

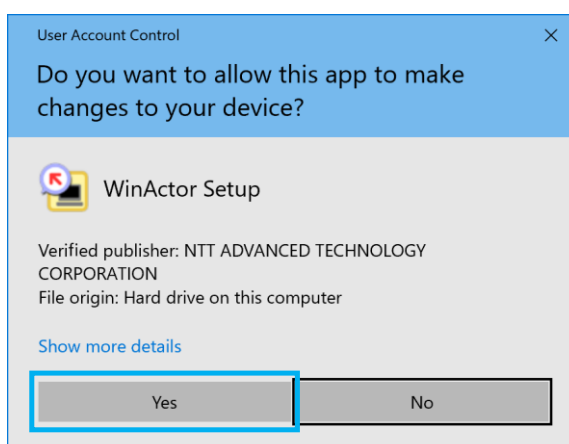
Steps

1. Start the installer "WinActorSetup.exe" in the "WinActor_Installer" folder.



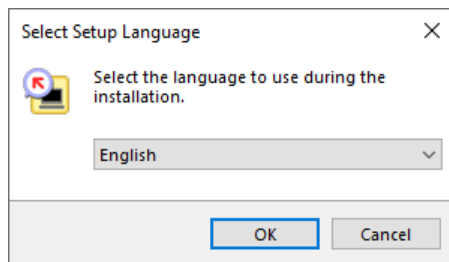
The 'User Account Control' dialog appears.

2. Click the 'Yes' button.



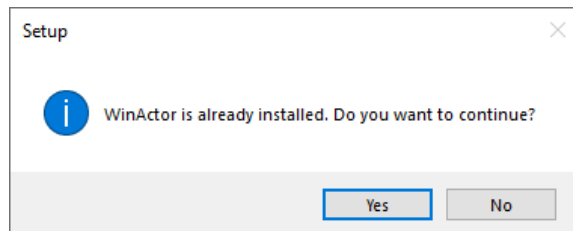
WinActor setup program will start.

3. If the 'Select Setup Language' dialog appears, select English and click the 'OK' button.



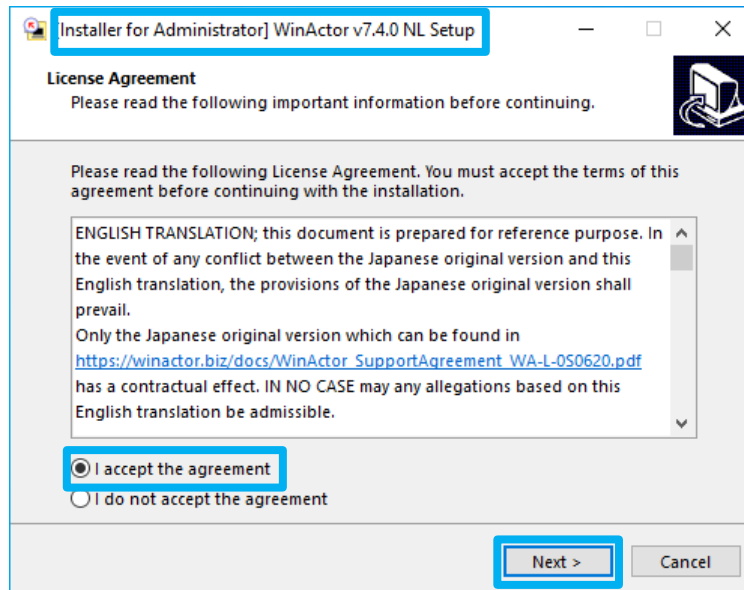
If WinActor Ver.7 is already installed, a confirmation dialog to overwrite the existing WinActor will be displayed.

Click the 'Yes' button to update to a new version of WinActor Ver.7. In that case, Step 5 (specifying a folder to install WinActor) will be skipped.



Click the 'No' button to cancel the installation.

4. Read through the entire end user license agreement, check "I accept the agreement" and then click the 'Next' button.



A step to specify a location to install WinActor will be displayed.

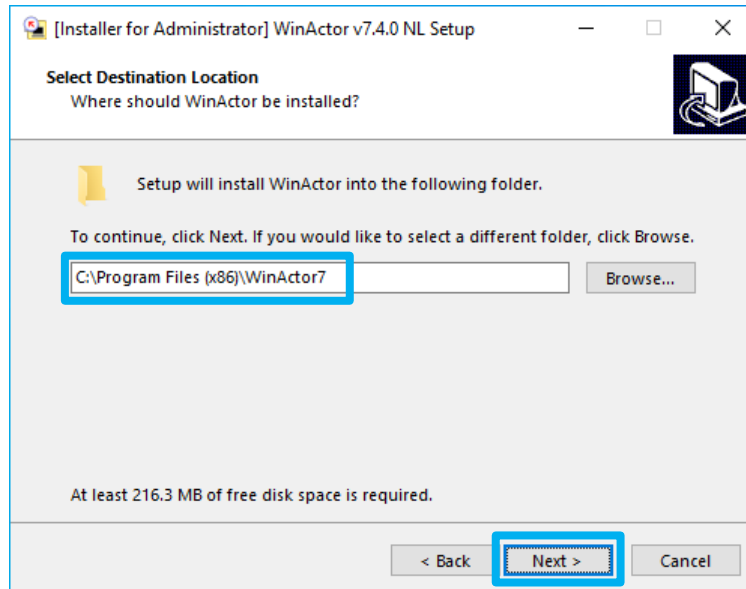


In the title of the installer for administrator, "[Installer for Administrator]," and the version number and the license type (NL or FL) of the WinActor are displayed.



For types of the license, see "2.2 Checking the license type."

5. Specify a folder to install WinActor and click the 'Next' button.
The initial folder name is "WinActor7."



A step to specify a Start Menu folder will be displayed.



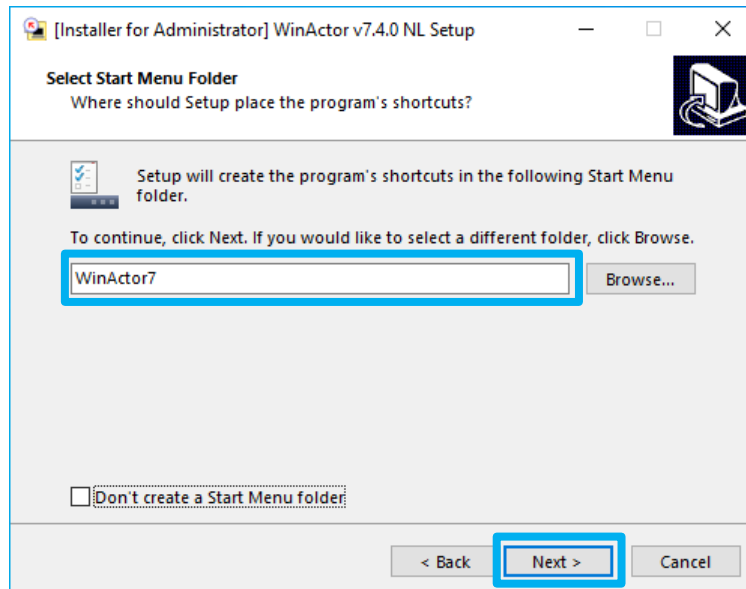
Do not install WinActor Ver.7 to the folder of WinActor Ver.5 or Ver.6.

6. Enter a Start Menu folder and click the 'Next' button.

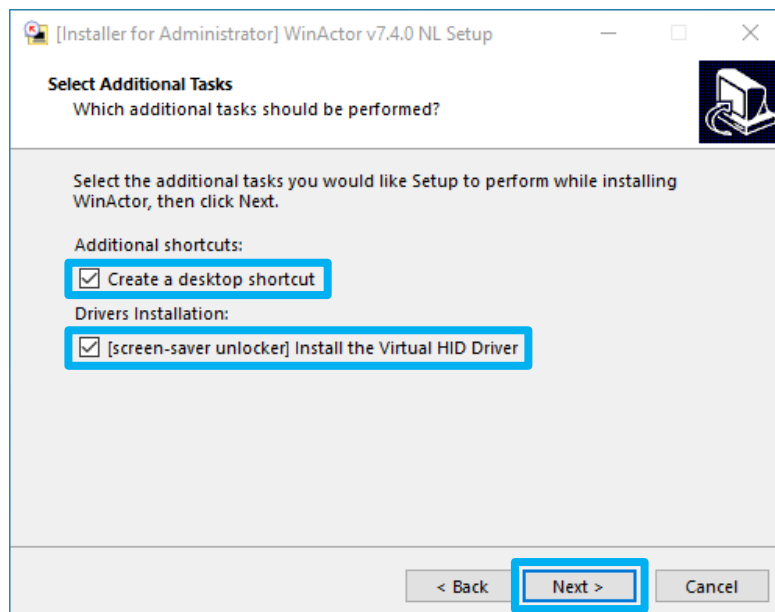


If you do not want to create a Start Menu folder, check "Don't create a Start Menu folder."



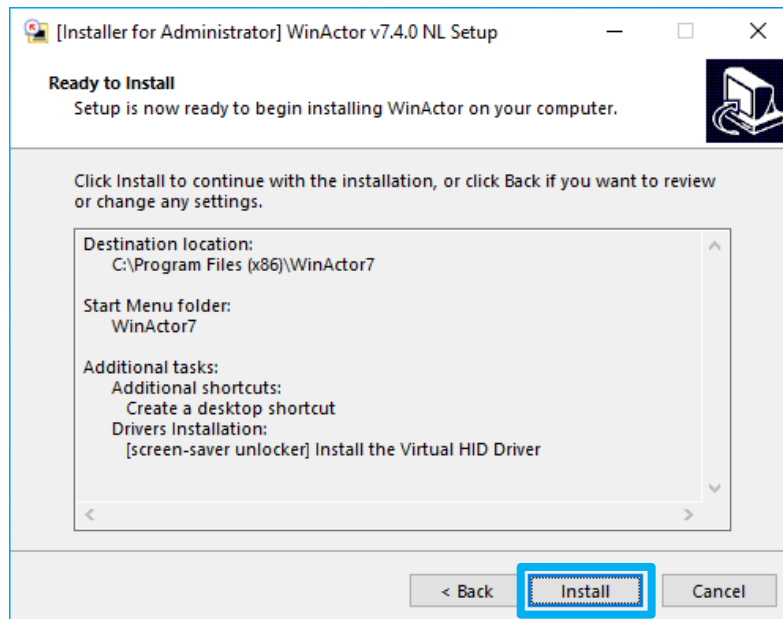
A step to select additional tasks will be displayed.

7. Select whether to create a desktop shortcut, and whether to install the driver to cancel the screen saver. After that, click the 'Next' button.



A step to confirm the installation contents will be displayed.

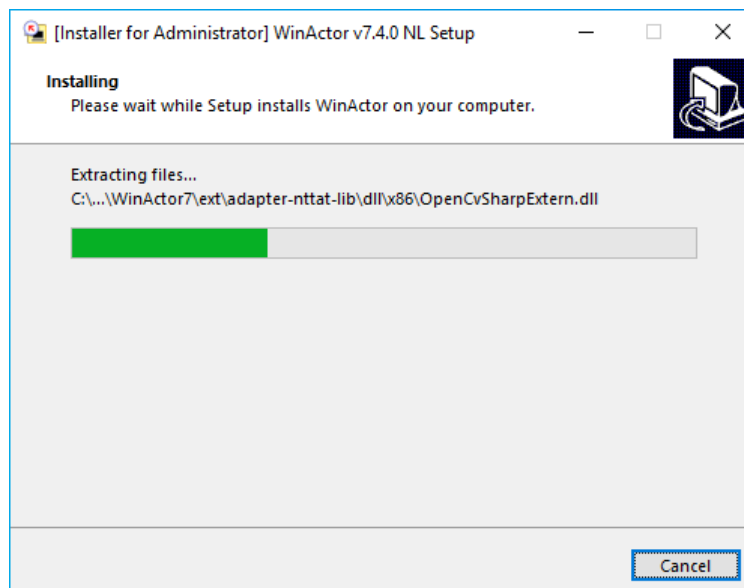
8. Check the contents and click the 'Install' button.



The installation progress will be displayed.

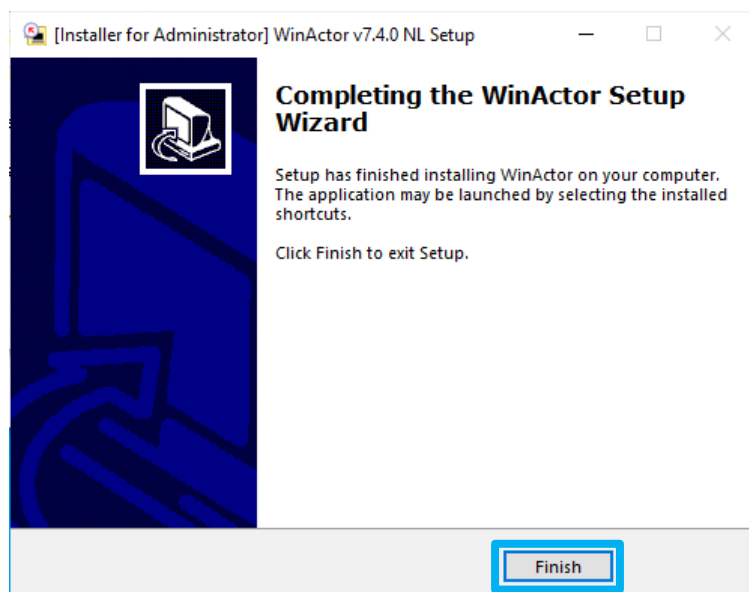


It may take about 10 minutes to complete the installation.



When the installation is completed, the following completion dialog appears.

9. Click the 'Finish' button.



1.2 Installer for standard user

This section describes the installation method for standard user.

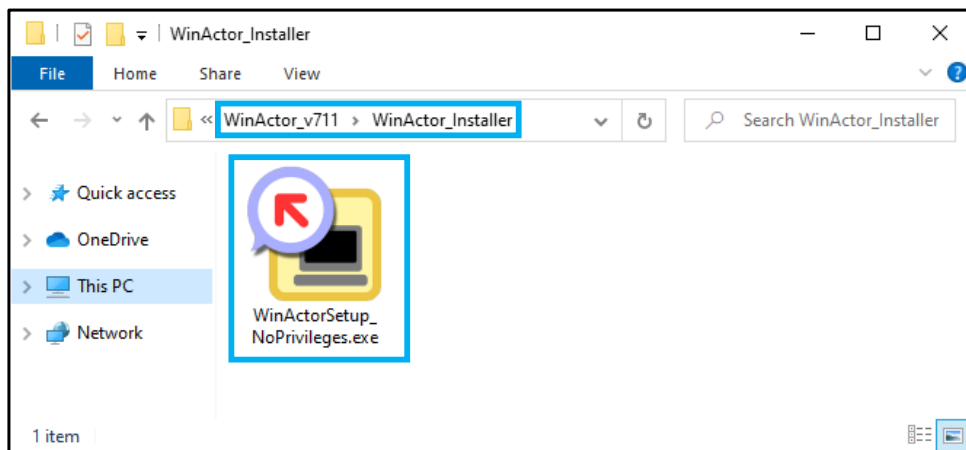
If you already have WinActor Ver.7 installed, you can update it with the same procedure.

1.2.1 Installation method for standard user

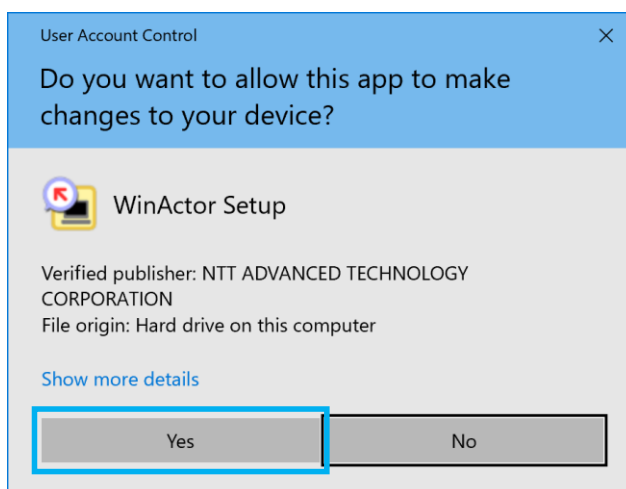
Install WinActor using the installer for standard user.

Steps

1. Start the installer "WinActorSetup_NoPrivileges.exe" in the "WinActor_Installer" folder.

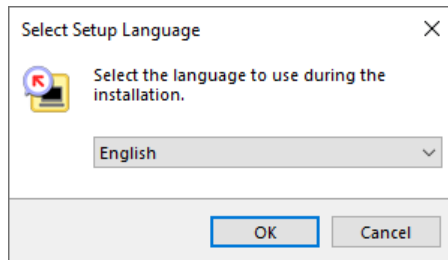


2. If the 'User Account Control' dialog appears, click the 'Yes' button.



WinActor setup program will start.

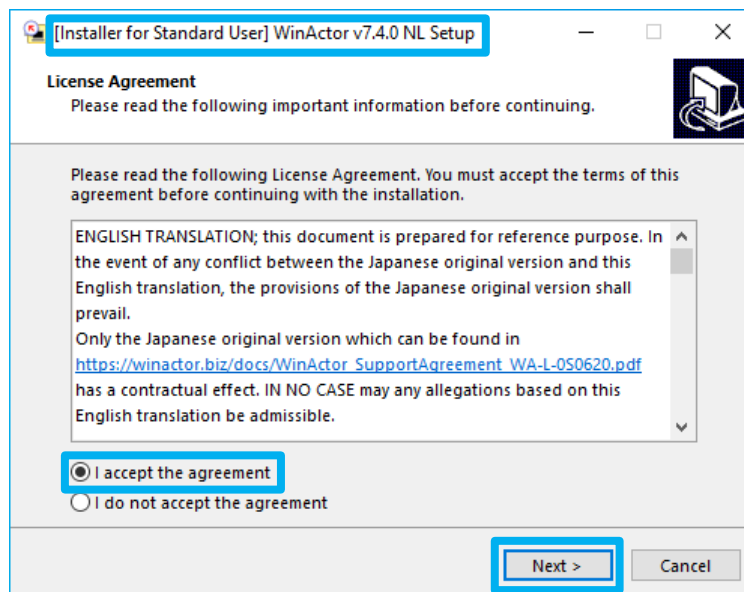
3. If the 'Select Setup Language' dialog appears, select English and click the 'OK' button.



4. Read through the entire end user license agreement, check "I accept the agreement" and then click the 'Next' button.



In the title of the installer for standard user, "[Installer for Standard User]" is displayed.



A step to specify a location to install WinActor will be displayed.

In the title of the installer for standard user, "[Installer for Standard User]," and the version number and the license type (NL or FL) of the WinActor are displayed.



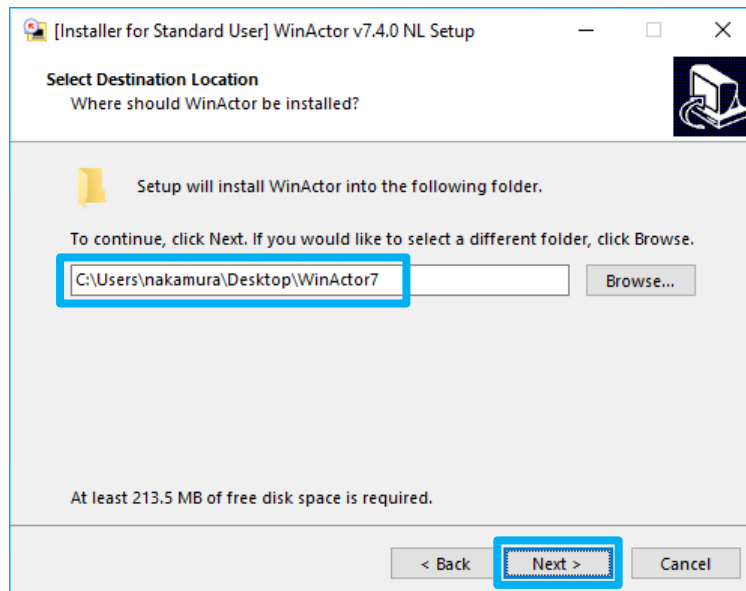
For types of the license, see "2.2 Checking the license type."

5. Specify a folder to install WinActor and click the 'Next' button.

The initial folder name is "WinActor7."



Specify a folder to which a standard user has write permission (such as Desktop for example).



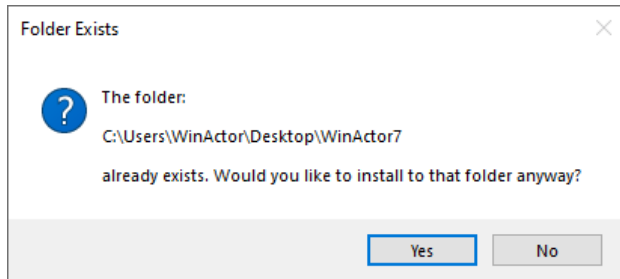
Do not install WinActor Ver.7 to the folder of WinActor Ver.5 or Ver.6.



For information on the handover of node-locked license of WinActor Ver.5 or Ver.6, see "3.4 Steps for registering a license by copying from Ver.5 or Ver.6."

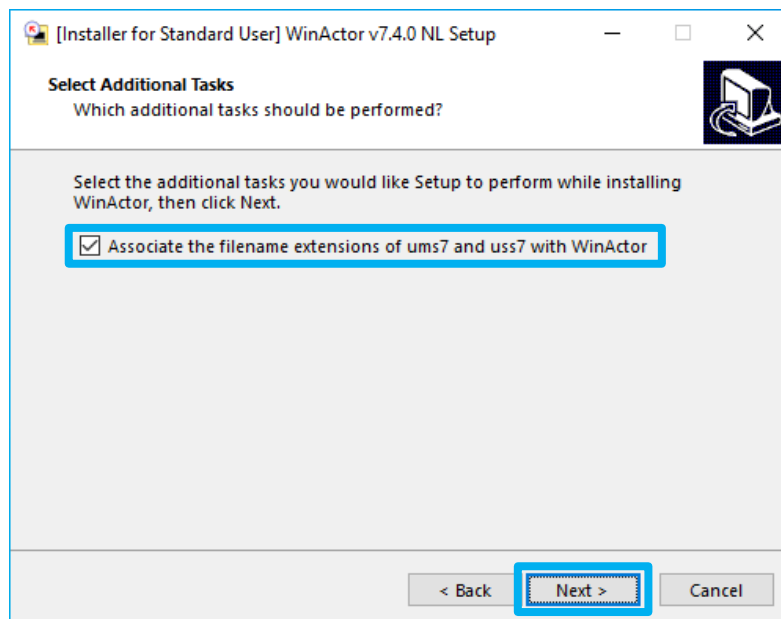
If the specified folder already exists, a confirmation dialog to overwrite the existing folder is displayed.

Click the 'Yes' button to update to a new version of WinActor Ver.7.



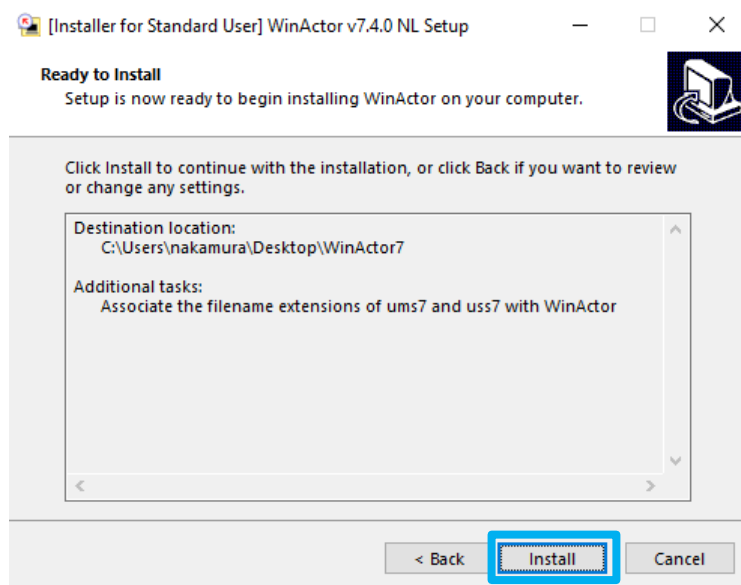
If you click the 'No' button, you will return to Step 5 (specifying a folder to install WinActor).

6. Select whether to associate scenario filename extensions with WinActor. After that, click the 'Next' button.



A step to confirm the installation contents will be displayed.

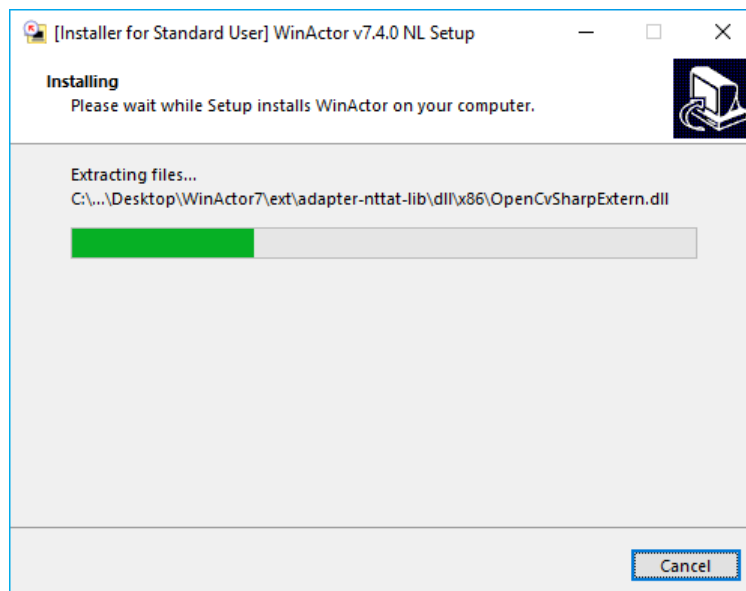
7. Check the contents and click the 'Install' button.



The installation progress will be displayed.

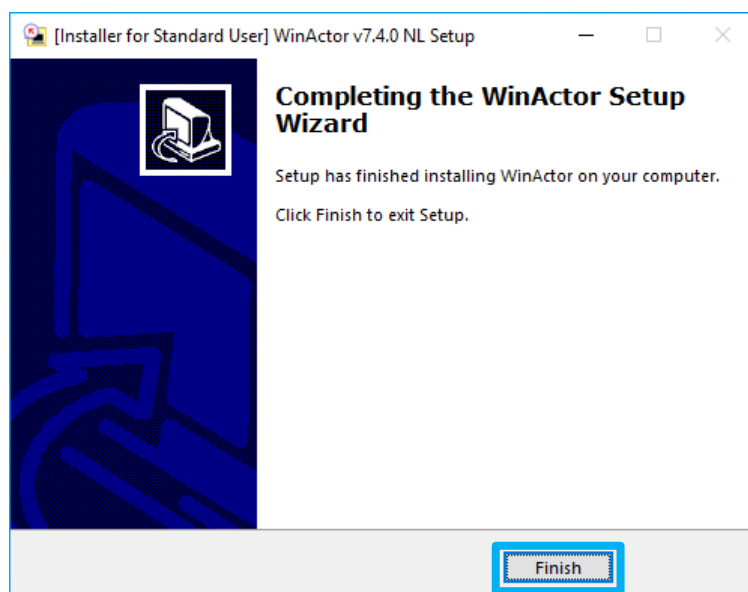


It may take about 10 minutes to complete the installation.



When the installation is completed, the following completion window appears.

8. Click the 'Finish' button after either of the following completion dialog is displayed.



1.3 Association of scenario files

The WinActor Ver.7 installer associates the filename extensions ums7 and uss7.

The filename extensions of the previous versions (ums5 and ums6) cannot be associated.

If you want to associate ums5 or ums6 with WinActor Ver.7, do it manually by using OS functions.



If the check box of "Associate the filename extensions of ums7 and uss7 with WinActor" is unchecked in the installer for standard user, ums7 and uss7 will not be associated.

1.4 Disassociation of scenario files

This section describes the procedure to disassociate the filename extensions ums7 and uss7.

If there is no need to disassociate, this step is unnecessary.



Follow these steps only if you need to disassociate the filename extensions.

Only the installer of WinActor Ver.7.1 or later supports disassociation.

Steps

1. Start Command Prompt.
2. At the Command Prompt, move to the folder where the WinActor installer is located.

Command example: When the installer is placed on the desktop

```
> cd C:\Users\Username\Desktop\WinActor_v711\WinActor_Installer
```

3. Run the installer with the option "/DELEXTASSOC" to disassociate the extension.

Command example: For the installer for administrator

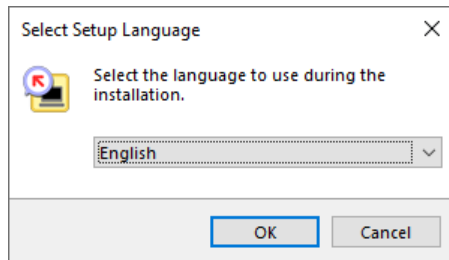
```
> WinActorSetup.exe /DELEXTASSOC
```

Command example: For the installer for standard user

```
> WinActorSetup_NoPrivileges.exe /DELEXTASSOC
```

4. If the User Account Control dialog appears, click the 'Yes' button.

5. If the 'Select Setup Language' dialog appears, select English and click the 'OK' button.



6. If the disassociation is successful, the dialog "Unassociated the filename extensions of ums7 and uss7 successfully." will be displayed.



1.5 Virtual keyboard driver for canceling the screen saver

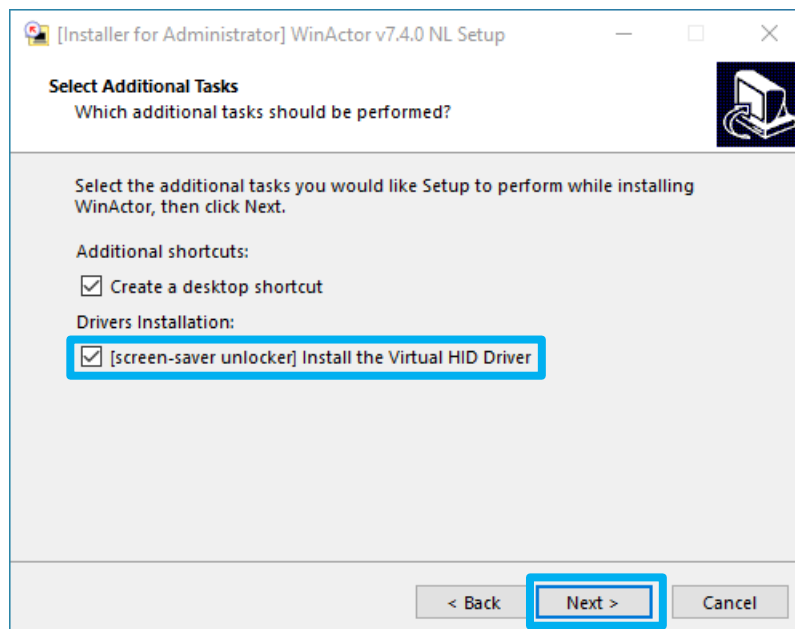
1.5.1 Install the driver

To use the function of canceling the screen saver, install the virtual keyboard driver which comes with WinActor.

■ Installation of the driver for administrator

Using the installer for administrator, you can install the virtual keyboard driver and WinActor at once.

Check the “[screen-saver unlocker] Install the Virtual HID Driver” checkbox in the “Select Additional Tasks” of WinActor installation wizard, and install WinActor.

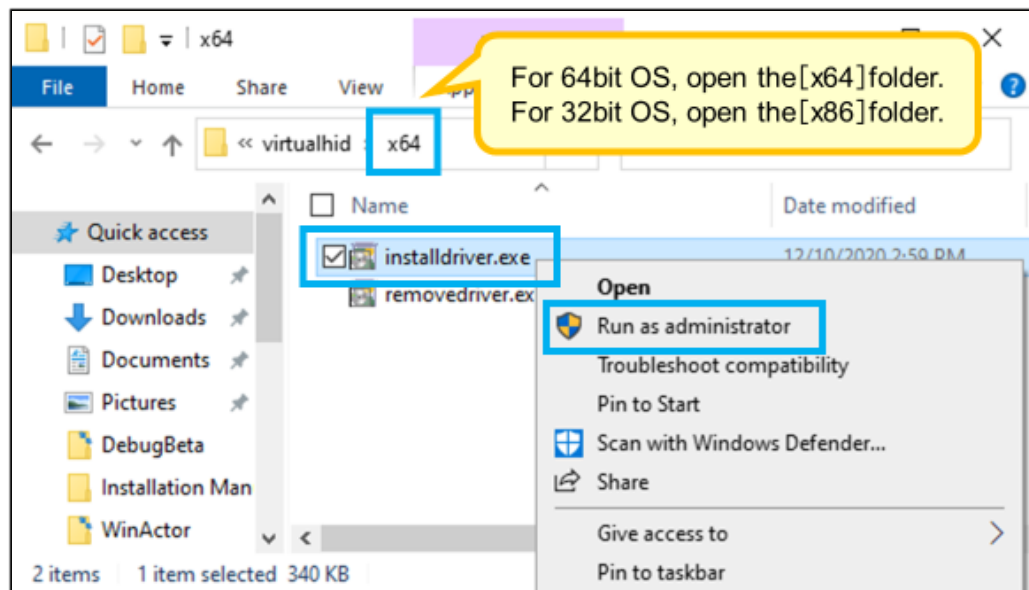


Even if you do not install the virtual keyboard drive and WinActor at once, you can still install the driver independently following the procedure in the next page.

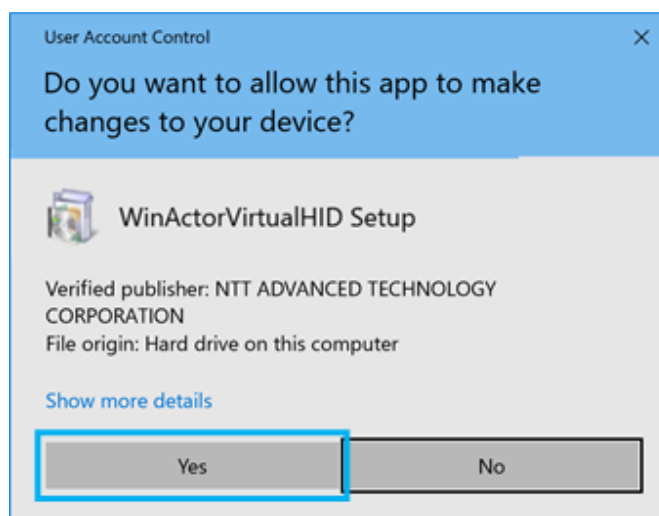
■ Installation of the driver for standard user

Steps

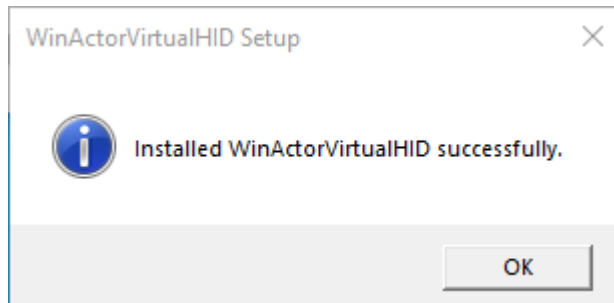
1. From the folder WinActor is installed, open “drivers,” and “virtualhid” consecutively. Then, open the folder in accordance with your Windows OS.
For 64bit OS, open the [x64] folder.
For 32bit OS, open the [x86] folder
After that, right-click “installdriver.exe” and select ‘Run as administrator’ to start installation.



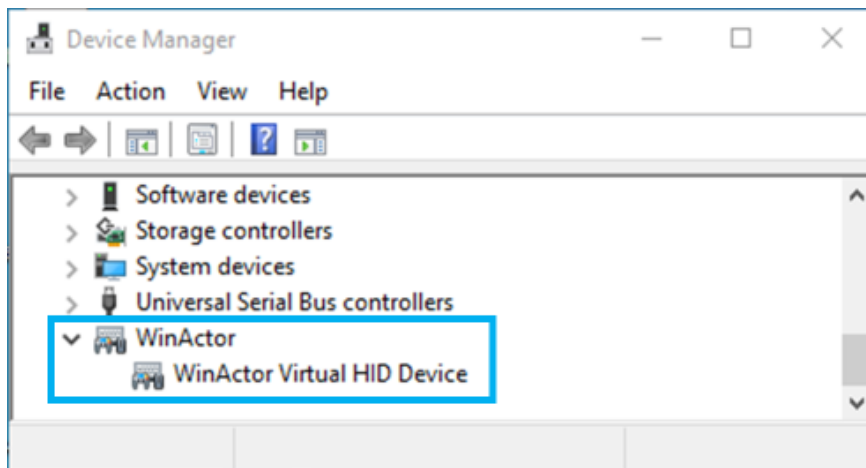
2. Click the ‘Yes’ button when ‘User Account Control’ dialog is displayed.
If username and password for administrator are required, enter them and click the ‘Yes’ button.



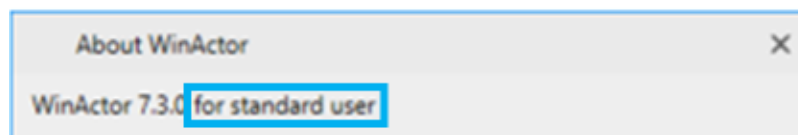
3. The dialog shown below will be displayed when the installation is successful. Click OK button.



4. Open 'Control Panel,' 'System and Security,' 'System,' and 'Device Manager' consecutively. Confirm that the item WinActor is added.



Seeing "for standard user" in the "About WinActor" window, you can confirm that your WinActor is installed with the installer for no privilege user.



1.5.2 Uninstall the driver

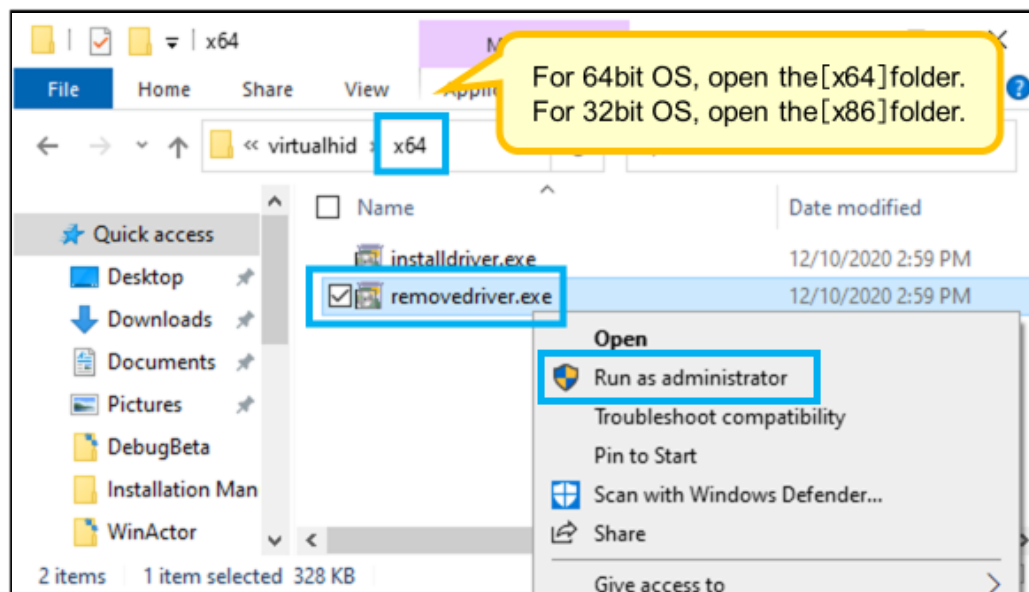
■ Uninstallation of the driver for administrator

The virtual keyboard driver will be uninstalled at once when you uninstall WinActor installed with the installer for administrator.

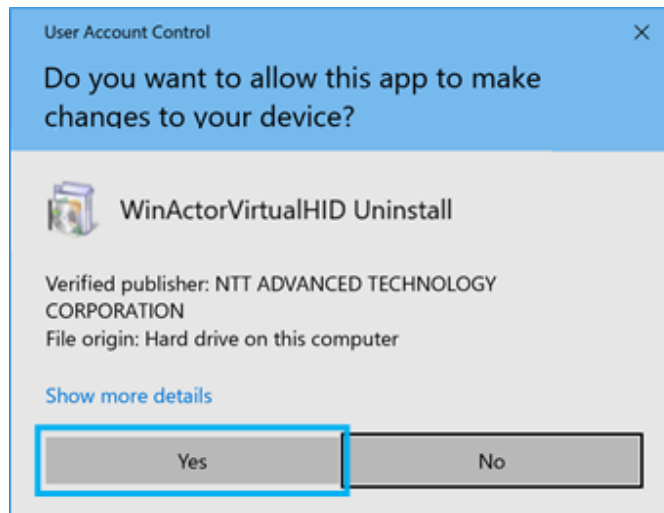
■ Uninstallation of the driver for standard user

Steps

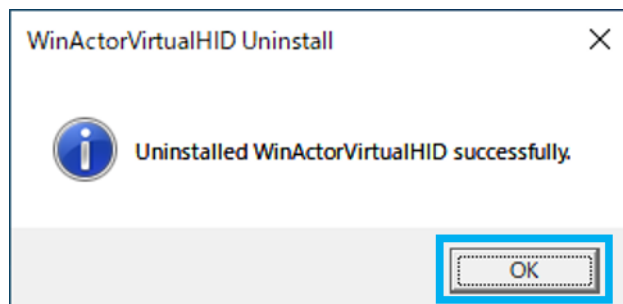
1. From the folder WinActor is installed, open “drivers,” and “virtualhid” consecutively. Then, open the folder in accordance with your Windows OS.
For 64bit OS, open the [x64] folder.
For 32bit OS, open the [x86] folder
After that, right-click “removedriver.exe” and select ‘Run as administrator’ to start uninstallation.



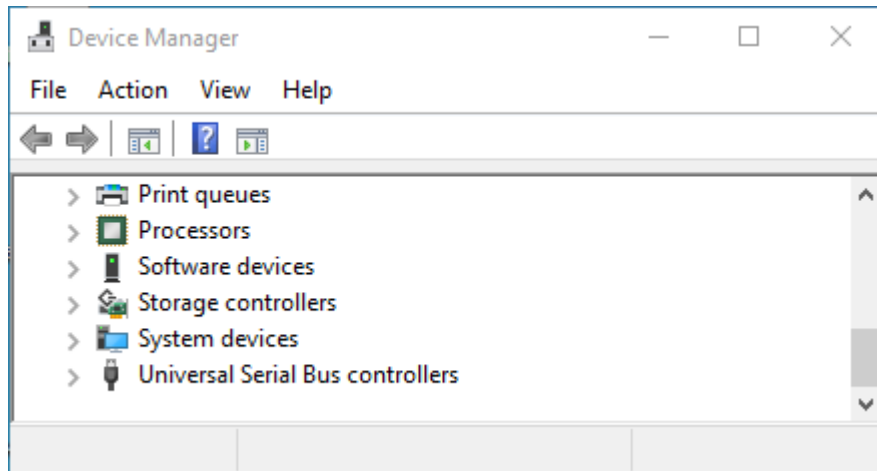
2. Click the 'Yes' button when 'User Account Control' dialog is displayed.
If username and password for administrator are required, enter them and click the 'Yes' button.



3. The dialog shown below will be displayed when the uninstallation is successful.
Click OK button.



4. Open 'Control Panel,' 'System and Security,' 'system,' and 'Device Manager' consecutively. Confirm that the item WinActor is removed.



The virtual keyboard driver will remain undeleted even if you remove the folder into which WinActor is installed.

Follow the procedure in this section to remove the virtual keyboard driver before you remove the folder into which WinActor is installed.

2. Launching WinActor

This chapter describes how to launch WinActor and how to check its license after launching.

2.1 Launching WinActor

Double-click the "WinActor7" icon placed on the desktop or "WinActor7.exe" under the WinActor folder.

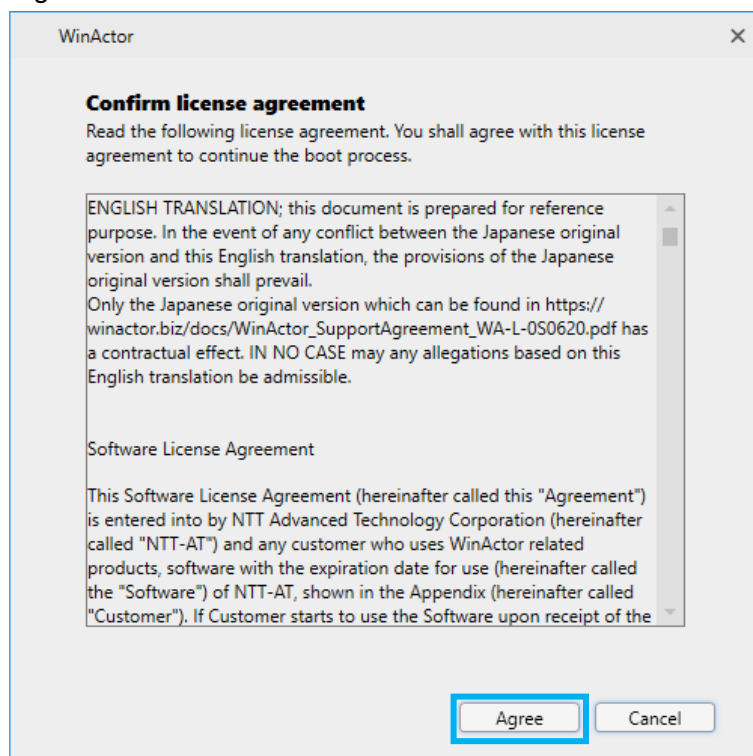


When there is no WinActor startup icon on the desktop:

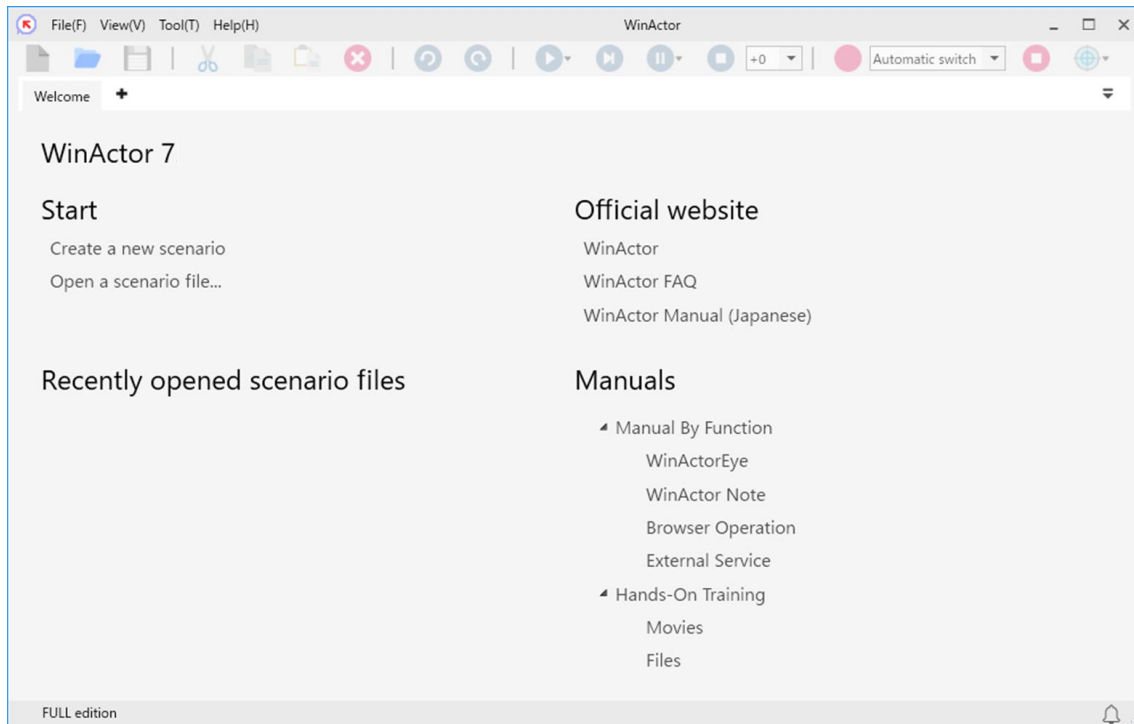
- When a shortcut was not created on the desktop during the installation: Launch WinActor7 from the Windows Start Menu.
 - When installed with the installer for standard user: Launch WinActor by double-clicking WinActor7.exe in the folder where WinActor is installed.

The end user license agreement is displayed at the first startup depending on the execution environment.

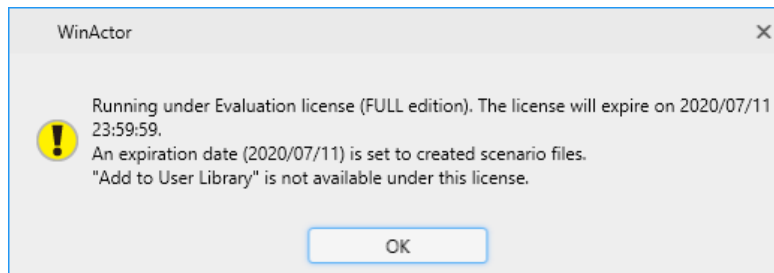
Read through the entire end user license agreement when it is displayed, and click the 'Agree' button.



WinActor launches and the following "Welcome page" appears.



If WinActor is running as an evaluation edition, the following window will be displayed. If you want to use it as a product edition, you need to set a license described in the following section.



2.2 Checking the license type

There are two types of WinActor licenses: Node-locked license and Floating license.

■ Node-locked license

This license is managed on a computer where WinActor is installed. The abbreviation is NL.



For a node-locked license, see "3 License registration" to register the license.

■ Floating license







This license is managed on a license management server. The abbreviation is FL.





For a floating license, see "5 Setting the license server connection information" to set the license.

The license type of the installed WinActor can be distinguished in the "About WinActor" dialog, the 'Option' dialog, and the 'Startup' window as shown in Table 2.2-1.

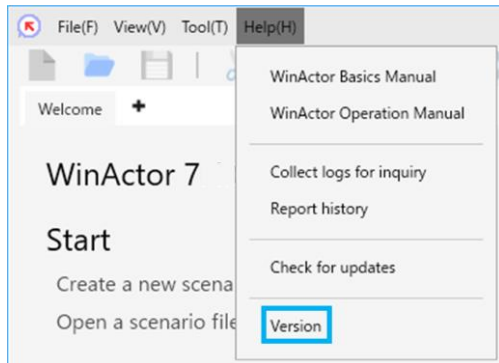

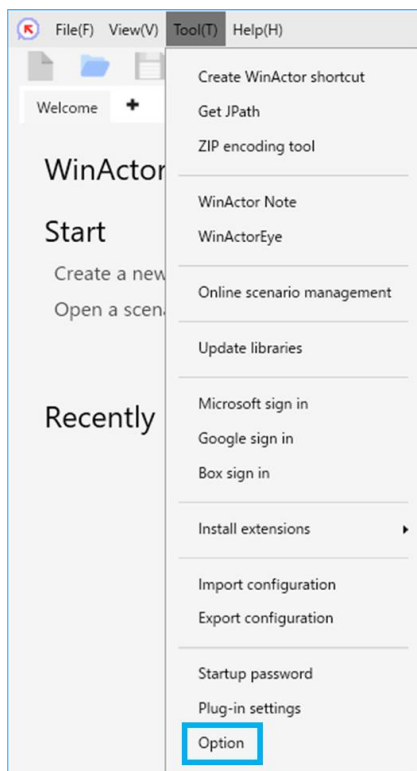
2.2.1 Displaying the About WinActor dialog

You can display the "About WinActor" dialog from 'Help' > 'Version' on the menu bar.



2.2.2 Displaying the Option dialog

You can display the 'Option' dialog from 'Tool' > 'Option' on the menu bar.



3. License registration

This chapter describes the procedure of the license registration for a node-locked license.

If you use the evaluation edition of WinActor, the steps in this chapter are not necessary.

You can register a node-locked license either online, via the WinActor license issuance site, or via a WinActor agency.

If you are using a node-locked license for WinActor Ver.5 or Ver.6, you can use the same license for Ver.7, and the steps in this chapter are not necessary. Proceed to the steps for registering a license by copying from Ver.5 or Ver.6.



"3.4 Steps for registering a license by copying from Ver.5 or Ver.6"

3.1 Online license registration

This section describes the procedure of registering a license online.

Once you complete registering a license online, you do not need to register it via a WinActor agency.



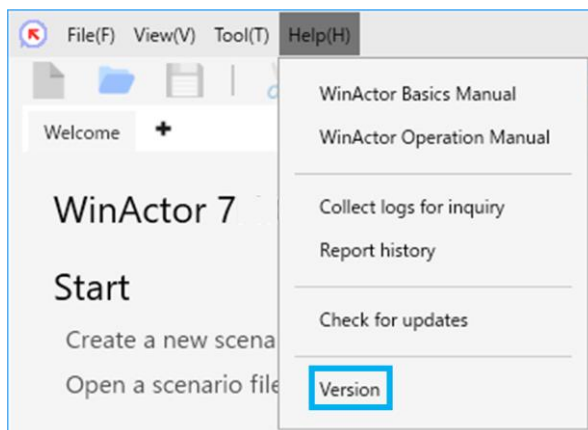
- Making a new license contract, you can use WinActor by registering the license online on or after the starting date of the license contract.
Renewing a license contract, you can continue using WinActor by registering the renewed license online prior to the termination date of the previous license contract.



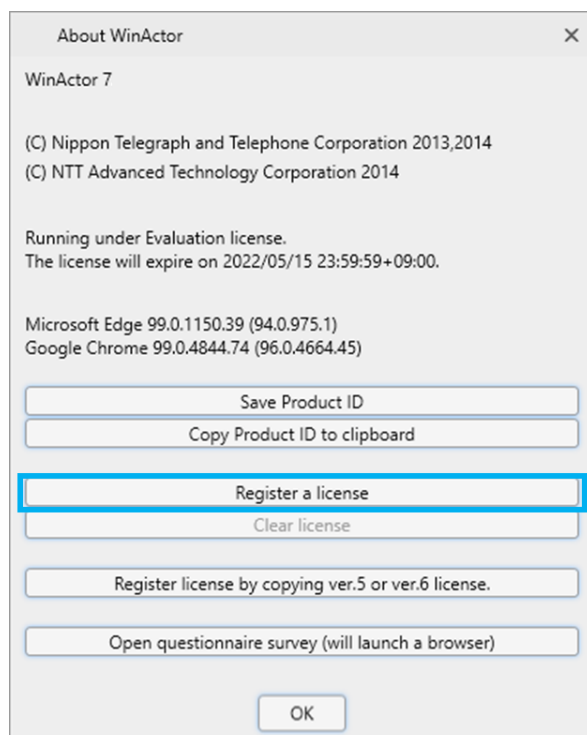
Settings on the 'Proxy server' tab in the 'Option' dialog are necessary for the network environment using a proxy server. See "WinActor operation manual" for the settings.

Steps

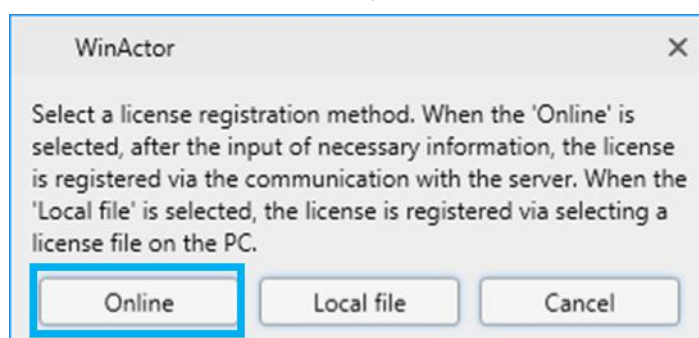
1. After launching WinActor, click 'Help' > 'Version' on the menu bar.



2. The "About WinActor" dialog appears.
Click the 'License registration' button.



3. The dialog to select a license registration method is displayed.
Click the 'Online' button to register a license online.



4. The 'Online license registration' dialog is displayed. Carefully input 'Support ID,' 'Termination date of the support period,' and 'License type.' Also, input a name for 'PC name.'

To notify the agency of the license issuance via e-mail, check the 'E-mail notification to the agency,' and input 'E-mail address of the agency,' 'User name,' and 'Company name of the user.'

Then, push 'Register' button.

Online license registration

Fill the boxes below and click 'Register' button to get a new license issued. When the 'Register' button is clicked, the communication with the server (https://) starts.

Check twice the 'Support ID', the 'License type', and the 'Termination date of the support period' to avoid an error. Specify any name that is unique in your environment for the "PC name".

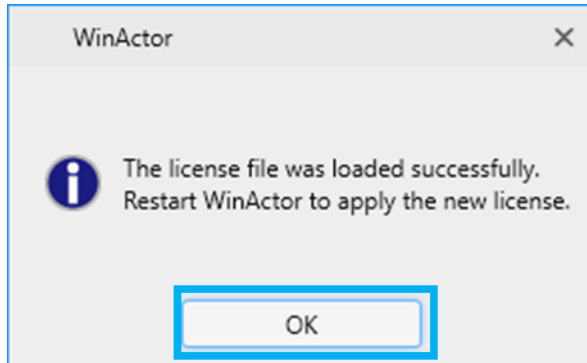

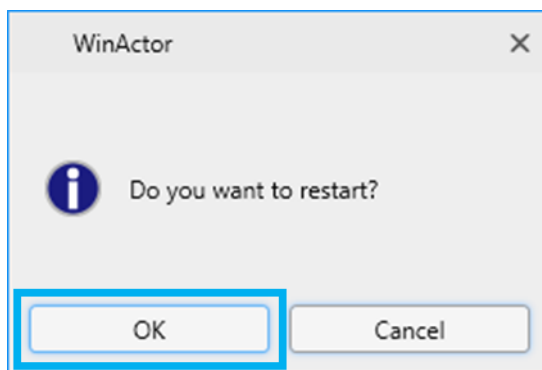

5. When the license registration succeeds, the following dialog is displayed.

Click the 'OK' button to relaunch WinActor and to reflect the registered license,

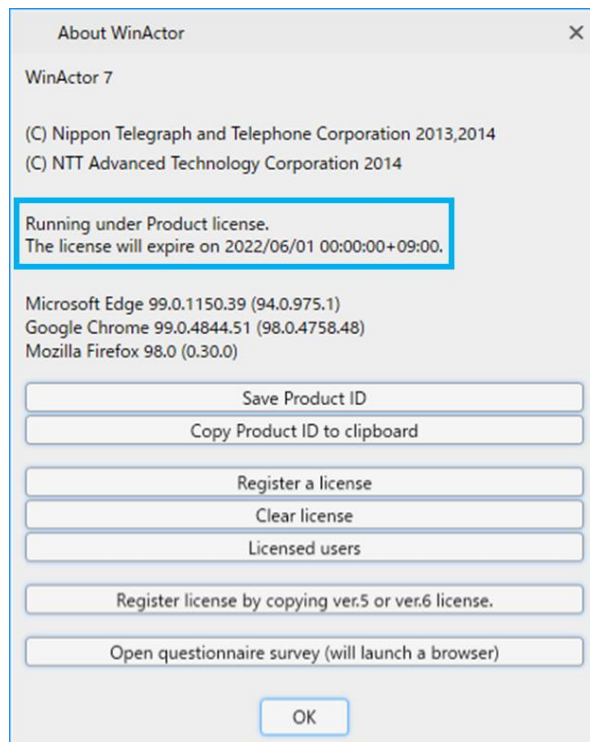


6. Click the 'OK' button again to relaunch WinActor.



7. Click 'Version' under 'Help' menu of the 'menu' bar on relaunched WinActor to display "About WinActor" dialog.

When "Running under Product license" is displayed, the license registration is completed.



3.2 License registration via WinActor license issuance site

The procedure of registering a license via the WinActor license issuance site is described in this section.



- In every procedure of the license issuance, renewal, and transfer, the support ID information printed on the “Robotic Process Automation Software WinActor Support ID Notification” is necessary. Before application, please have it on hand.
 - For the ‘license issuance’ procedure to be carried out at the first contract, or the ‘license renewal’ procedure to be carried out at the time of the contract renewal, follow the procedure described in “3.2.1 License issuance and renewal.”
Customers who concluded a new contract can use WinActor by applying for the ‘license issuance’ and registering the issued license file on WinActor after the start date of the support period.
Customers who renewed the contract can continue using WinActor by applying for the ‘license renewal’ and registering the renewed license file on WinActor before the termination date of the previous support period.
Record the PC (Product ID) for which you applied for the license issuance or renewal.
 - When the major version number of WinActor is upgraded (e.g., 4.3.2→5.2.1), make a new contract and apply for the ‘license issuance.’
However, when upgrading from Ver.5 or Ver.6 to Ver.7, proceed with the procedure, referring “3.4 Steps for registering a license by copying from Ver.5 or Ver.6.”
When the minor version number of WinActor is updated (e.g., 5.1.3→5.2.1), ‘license issuance’ is not necessary.
 - Apply for the ‘license transfer’ when the PC or the OS on which WinActor is installed is broken or replaced.
The ‘license transfer’ is carried out not by support ID but by license
Carry out the transfer procedure, contacting your agency and referring “4.2 License transfer via WinActor license issuance site.”
 - If you have any trouble in carrying out the license issuance, renewal, or transfer procedure, or if you have points to be cleared, contact your agency.

3.2.1 License issuance and renewal

Carry out the 'license issuance' or 'license renewal' procedure when applying for a license at the first time or renewing a license at the time of the contract renewal.

Steps

1. Connect to the WinActor license issuance site, and display the "WinActor license application form."



- (1) Click 'Help(H)' and 'Version' from the WinActor menu bar consecutively.

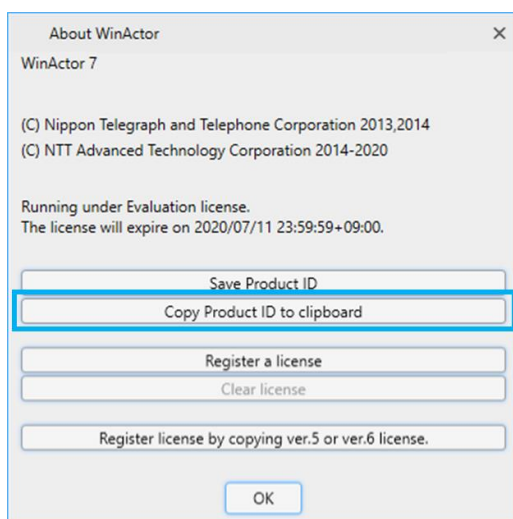

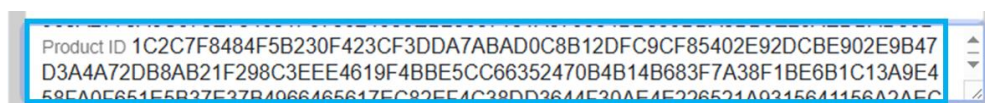

The product ID is copied to the clipboard.

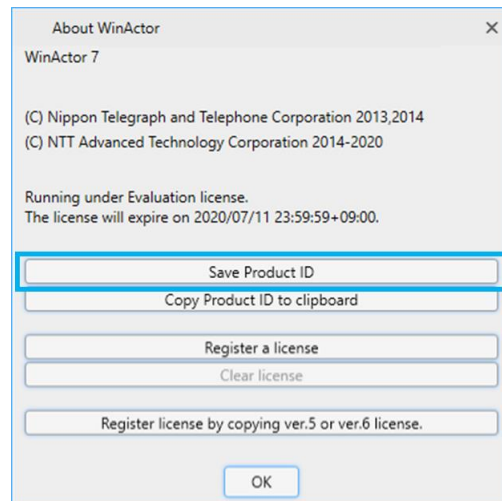
- (3) Paste the copied product ID into the 'Product ID' box.



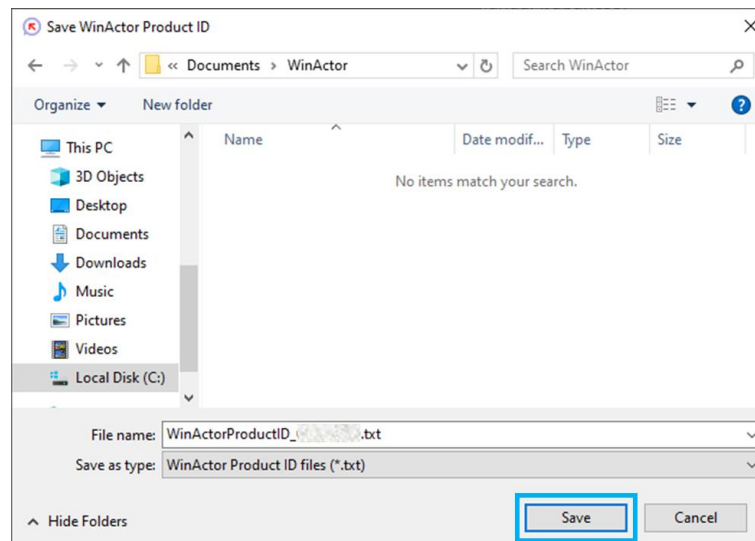


Product ID can be entered by dragging and dropping the 'Product ID file' into the 'Product ID' box. The procedure is described below.

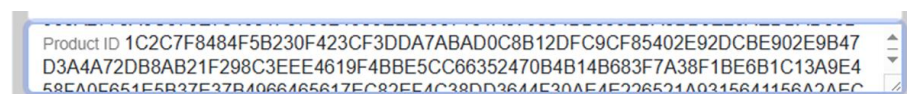
- (1) Click the 'Save Product ID' button to create a 'Product ID file.'



- (2) The initial filename is "WinActorProductID_XXXXXXX.txt" where "XXXXXXX" is some alphanumeric letters. Click the 'Save' button.



- (3) Drag and drop the 'Product ID file' into the 'Product ID' box.





When the PC to use WinActor is different from the PC to input the application form, click the 'Save Product ID' button on the PC to use WinActor, and create a 'Product ID file'.

Copy the 'Product ID file' to the PC to input the application form, and carry out either of the following procedures.

1. Copy the contents of the 'Product ID file' to the clipboard, and paste it into the 'Product ID' box.
2. Drag and drop the 'Product ID file' into the 'Product ID' box.

7. When the notification to the agency is preferred, check the "Notify the agency of the license issuance by e-mail" box.

8. Enter 'E-mail address of the agent (e-mail address to notify),' 'The name of the user,' and 'the company name of the user.'

Up to 3 e-mail addresses of the agency can be entered.





9. Read through the "PRIVACY POLICY" page, and check the 'Agree' box.

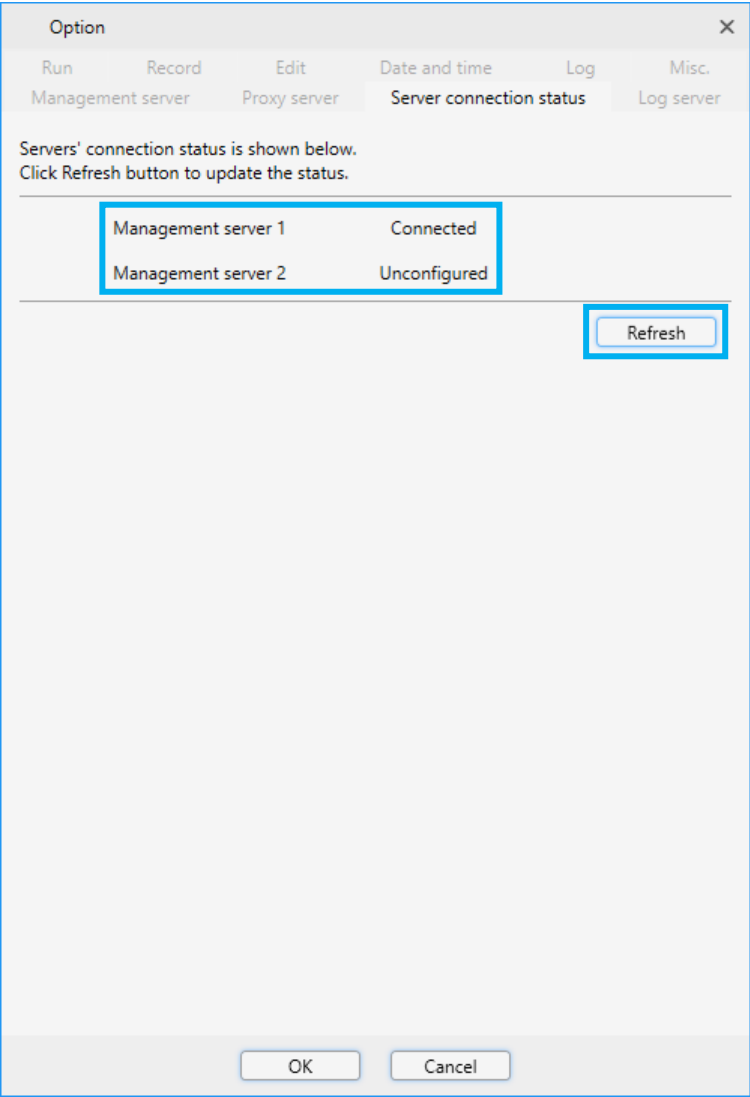
The 'Option' dialog appears.

Unconfigured	Displayed when the information required for connection is not configured.
